THE ROLE OF THE FOUNDATION

The Michigan Nurses Foundation (MNF) advances nursing and nursing education by awarding educational scholarships and research grants to nurses and nursing students. The Foundation also supports nurses recovering from substance use. The

Michigan Nurses Foundation is funded through private contributions and fundraising activities. These funds are held and invested by the Capital Region Community Foundation.

TREATMENT ASSISTANCE

The Foundation provides treatment grants to licensed healthcare professionals which can be used on behalf of the award recipients. Nurses who have entered a substance misuse recovery program or other approved program to regain their license can apply for financial assistance with program fees.

NURSING SCHOLARSHIPS

The Foundation awards a minimum of four nursing student scholarships each year.

Applicants must be a student currently enrolled in a Michigan college/school of nursing that grants an associate, baccalaureate or higher degree in nursing, and is in good academic standing.

SAFE NURSING PRACTICE SCHOLARSHIP

The Safe Nursing Practice Scholarship provides up to \$2,000 for MNA union members to attend national healthcare/ specialty conferences. This scholarship enables members to strengthen their nursing practice, expand their expertise and share information gained with nurses and staff in their healthcare system.

EVELYN GRACE PERAINO AWARD

Evelyn Grace passed away at 3.5 months old in 2018. This scholarship is in honor of all the nurses that cared for her, the love and support consistently given to her and her family, and their genuine concern and passion for pediatric patient care. Evelyn

RESEARCH IN NURSING GRANT
